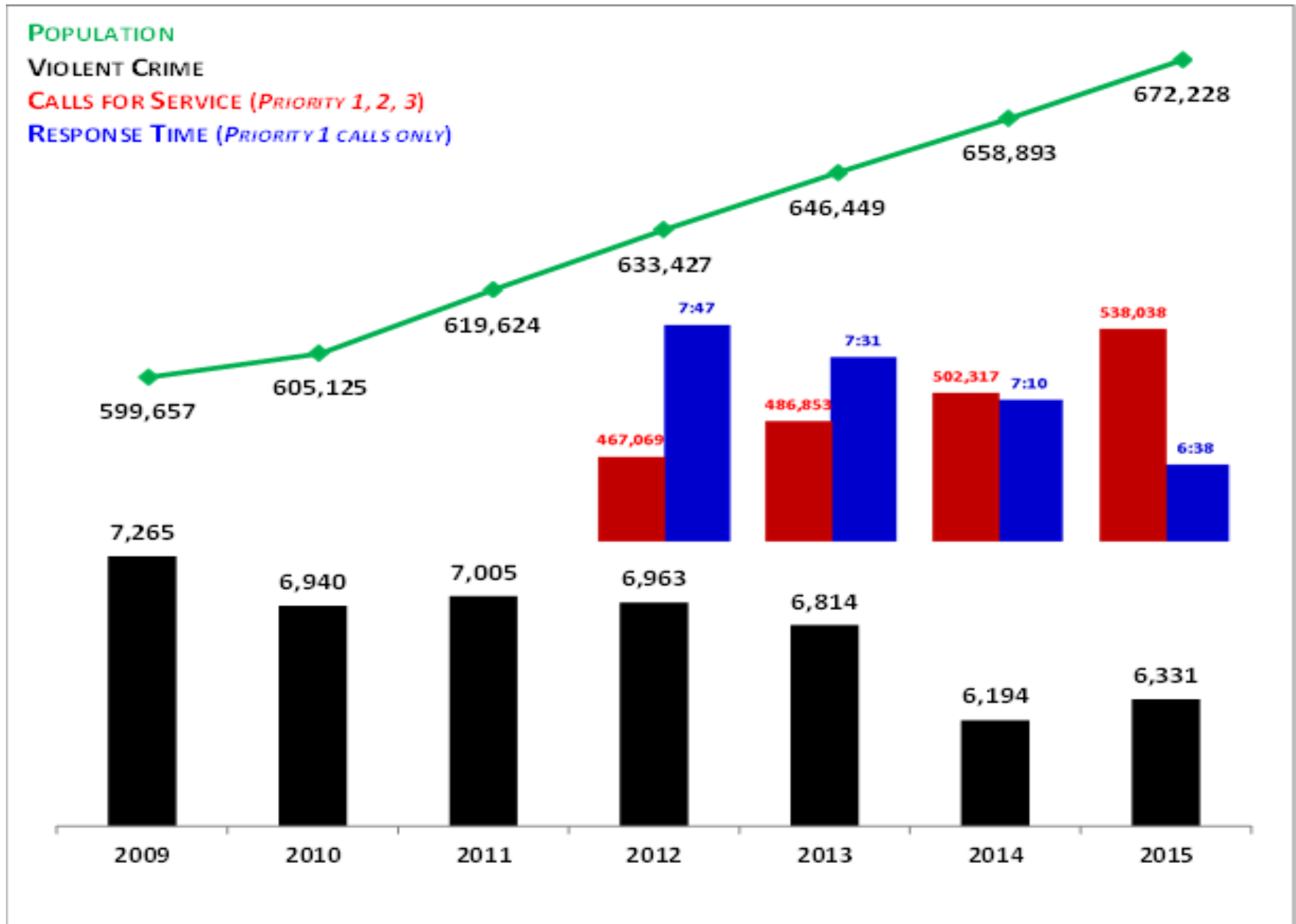

# SECURITY CAMERA INCENTIVE PROGRAM

- Mayoral program signed into law on January 15, 2016
- Provides a rebate for residents, business, nonprofits, and religious institutions to purchase and install security cameras on their property and register them with MPD
- Provides a rebate of \$200 per camera with a max rebate of \$500 per residential addresses and \$750 for all other addresses
- Camera system must have been purchased and installed on property after September 22, 2015
- You can get information on the program, including camera specifications, as well as register your camera and apply for a rebate on the Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants website ([www.ovsjg.dc.gov](http://www.ovsjg.dc.gov))
